- **R. S. Varma Best Paper Award Competition:** Persons registered for Ph.D. in a university/ institute can submit their papers for 'R.S. Varma Best Paper Award Contest.' There is a cash award of **350 USD** and a merit certificate for the winner. To be qualified for this competition, the student has to be the principal contributor to the paper and present it during the conference.
- The best paper award will be given at the end of the conference.

The 28th International Conference of the Forum for Interdisciplinary Mathematics is co-organized by the Department of Management Control and Information Systems, University of Chile, Santiago and the Forum for Interdisciplinary Mathematics.

The academic program of the conference will provide a unique meeting point for researchers, academics and students to interact and discuss their research ideas and present the latest enhancements and innovations in interdisciplinary mathematics, statistics and computational intelligence. The conference will consist of keynote addresses, invited talks, plenary talks, oral and poster presentations, symposia on different themes, Ph.D. Scholar best paper award competition.

**Abstract/Paper Submission-** Authors are requested to submit an abstract (carrying title, name(s) and affiliation(s) of the author(s), running in about 500 words) in English. Please use the online abstract submission link for submitting your abstract. Those interested in publishing their papers in Springer proceedings should submit full-length papers running in no more than 12 pages. All accepted abstract submissions will be published in an accompanying CD-ROM Proceedings. For more information regarding the abstract/paper submission, visit the conference website.

**Conference Proceedings-** All submitted papers will be peer-reviewed and accepted papers will be published in a book of proceedings by Springer in its book series '**Advances in Intelligent Systems and Computing**'. The proceedings will be indexed in major databases, including the Web of Science and Scopus.

**Special Issues** - Extended versions of selected papers will be published in special issues of international journals indexed in the Web of Science-Journal Citation Reports.
